El Dorado Kansas Meet Results – September 2012

Thanks to everyone who attended, it was a wonderful weekend – 38 Chargers showed up for the 14<sup>th</sup> Annual Charger Fever Weekend. We gathered Saturday and Sunday at the Kansas Oil Museum with the year count for Chargers as follows: 1966 – 3, 1967 – 2, 1968 – 5, 1969 – 8, 1970 – 3, 1971 – 2, 1973 – 4, 1975 - 1, 2006 – 4, 2008 – 2, 2012 – 2, and two chargers that did not register (mystery Chargers #32 & #36). States that were represented: KS – 22, OK – 7, MO – 3, NE – 2, MN – 1 & IL – 1. Charger owners that attended without their cars KS – 7, TX – 1.

Our participant's choice was a 1968 Dark Green Charger R/T scat pack from Kansas owned by Tom and Alexis Wood. He found the '68 behind a barn and after a year and a half of talking with the owner and promising the owner that he would restore the Charger he agreed to sell it to Tom. Tom spent the next 8 years doing a total ground up restoration on the Charger by himself, leaning as he continued working on the Charger. Tom did a beautiful job on the Charger.




The Saturday cruise consisted of 31 people in 13 Chargers and a GTX convertible that cruised to Stearman Field Bar & Grill in Benton, KS for dinner.
